	adequately the functions allocated to it by the Convention on
	International Civil Aviation, as revealed by the ICAO USOAP
	Audit in May/June 2023.
	In Consideration of the various efforts and interventions by the
	Government of Sierra Leone, the SLCAA, the International
	Civil Aviation Organisation (ICAO), the African Civil
	Aviation Commission (AFCAC), the European Aviation Safety
	Agency (EASA), the Banjul Accord Group Aviation Safety
	Oversight Organisation (BAGASOO), Italian Civil Aviation
	Authority (ENAC) and other organizations, towards the
	enhancement of the safety oversight capacity of SLCAA;
