DIRECTIVE NO	SLCAA/CAD/2024/001
SUBJECT	A Directive requiring the Sierra Leone Civil Aviation Authority (SLCAA) to register aircraft and issue licenses and certificates.
BASIS/COMMENCEMENT	Pursuant to the powers vested on the Director General by Sections 17 and 49 of The Civil Aviation Act 2023, the SLCAA hereby issues directive as contained in this document
APPLICABILITY	SLCAA/SERVICE PROVIDERS/PUBLIC
REASON(S)	<p>Recognizing that the current safety oversight capability of Sierra Leone has improved such that it is able to discharge adequately the functions allocated to it by the Convention on International Civil Aviation, as revealed by the ICAO USOAP Audit in May/June 2023.</p> <p>In Consideration of the various efforts and interventions by the Government of Sierra Leone, the SLCAA, the International Civil Aviation Organisation (ICAO), the African Civil Aviation Commission (AFCAC), the European Aviation Safety Agency (EASA), the Banjul Accord Group Aviation Safety Oversight Organisation (BAGASOO), Italian Civil Aviation Authority (ENAC) and other organizations, towards the enhancement of the safety oversight capacity of SLCAA;</p>
ACTIONS REQUIRED AND COMPLIANCE TIMELINES	The Sierra Leone Civil Aviation Authority, with immediate effect, shall resume the Issuance, Conversion or Validation of all licences and certificates.
