The purpose of the Maintenance Training Manual (MTM) Checklist is to assist owners / operators with a view to ensuring that the MTM submitted to the SLCAA for approval are standardized and include all items that are required by SLCARs Part 8B and Part 26. This checklist, when completed, should be submitted with the draft MTM. This checklist should clearly show either compliance (yes) & location of the compliance in the notes section or not

applicable (no) & the reason in the notes section.

The relevant cross-references (subsection number and page number) shall be specified in the notes column at the appropriate paragraphs and the correct term MTM shall be used. It is not acceptable to simply enter the MTM as the cross-reference.

The checklist is provided to ensure the minimum required items are contained in the MTM.
